5. Cancellation Requests & ETF Disputes

Cancellation is one of the top reasons Texas customers call. A \$250 early termination fee has been specifically documented in Texas BBB complaints. Always request written email confirmation after requesting cancellation to prevent continued billing.

6. Contract Term Clarification

Texas customers frequently call to understand whether they signed a 1-year or 2-year contract, when their term ends, what the monthly billing schedule looks like, and whether the contract auto-renews. Door-to-door sales in Texas have generated complaints about 2-year contracts being presented without full verbal disclosure.

7. Missed or Skipped Scheduled Visits

Texas BBB records include cases where customers paid monthly fees for 6+ months while receiving no service visits. One documented case involved a customer taking time off work for three consecutive scheduled visits, none of which were honored. Call to report missed visits, request makeup appointments, and seek billing credits.

8. Fire Ant Infestations

Red imported fire ants are one of the most common Texas pest complaints, particularly in suburban yards across DFW, Houston, and San Antonio. Customers call to schedule fire ant treatments or request a re-service when mounds reappear after a recent treatment.

9. Cockroach & Water Bug Infestations

How to Cancel Greenix Service in Texas

Understanding Your Texas Greenix Contract

- Standard term: 12-month contract — some Texas customers report being enrolled in 2-year agreements via door-to-door sales
- Monthly billing: charges are collected monthly even though service visits occur quarterly
- Early termination fee (ETF): \$250 specifically documented in Texas BBB complaints; may range up to \$328+
- 3-day right to cancel: Texas law provides a 3-business-day window to cancel contracts signed at your home (door-to-door sales)
- After the 3-day window: 30 days' written notice is typically required
- Auto-renewal: contracts may renew automatically — confirm your renewal date before the term ends
- Contract access: you are entitled to a copy of your signed contract — request it if you did not receive one

Texas Right to Cancel — Door-to-Door Sales Law

Under the Texas Business & Commerce Code, if a Greenix representative came to your home to sell you a service contract, you have 3 business days from the date of signing to cancel the contract without penalty. This right applies to in-home solicitation sales. The seller is legally required to provide written notice of this right at the time of signing. If you were not provided this notice, your cancellation rights may extend beyond 3 days. Contact the Texas Attorney General's Office for guidance if your rights were not disclosed.

Steps to Cancel Greenix Service in Texas

1. Call +1 (800) 888-8888 and state clearly that you wish to cancel your service
2. Provide your Texas service address and account number
3. Ask to speak with a manager or cancellation specialist — standard agents may lack authority to process cancellations
4. Cite the Texas 3-day right to cancel if your contract was signed during a door-to-door visit and you are within that window
5. Request email confirmation of your cancellation before ending the call
6. Immediately follow up with a written cancellation email to Greenix — include the date, time, and agent name from your call
7. Save a screenshot of your sent email with the full timestamp
8. Monitor your bank or card statements for at least two billing cycles after cancellation
9. If charges continue, dispute them with your bank and provide the written cancellation email as evidence
10. If unresolved, file a complaint with the Texas Attorney General or BBB

Warning: Texas BBB records include cases where customers paid \$456+ in monthly fees for a single service visit and were still charged a \$250 cancellation fee. If you

believe your contract was not clearly disclosed at signing — especially for door-to-door sales — reference your Texas right to cancel and escalate immediately to a manager.

Common Pests Greenix Treats in Texas

Red Imported Fire Ants

German Cockroach

The most prevalent indoor cockroach in Texas urban areas including Dallas and Houston apartment complexes. German cockroaches reproduce rapidly and are resistant to many consumer products. Professional treatment is essential for full elimination.

Striped Bark Scorpion

Texas has the highest scorpion population in the continental U.S. The striped bark scorpion is found statewide — from suburban DFW to the Texas Hill Country and San Antonio. Its sting is venomous and particularly dangerous to children and pets. Greenix perimeter treatments target scorpion entry points and hiding areas.

Subterranean Termites

Texas is one of the highest-risk states for termite damage in the country. Eastern subterranean termites are active across DFW, Houston, and East Texas. Formosan termites have been established in Houston and South Texas. Combined termite pressure costs Texas homeowners hundreds of millions annually.

Mosquitoes

Houston consistently ranks among the top U.S. cities for mosquito density due to its Gulf Coast location, high humidity, and warm temperatures. Kissing Bugs (Triatoma)

The seller must provide written notice of this right at signing. If you were not given this notice, call +1 (800) 835-5832 and also contact the Texas Attorney General's Office at (800) 621-0508.

Q: Is Greenix signing Texas customers to 1-year or 2-year contracts?

A: Most Greenix plans are 12-month contracts with monthly billing. However, Texas BBB records include cases of customers discovering they signed 2-year agreements via door-to-door sales presentations. Always request a copy of your signed contract and confirm the exact term length before agreeing to service.

Q: What is the cancellation fee for Greenix in Texas?

A: A \$250 early termination fee has been specifically documented in Texas BBB complaints. ETFs may range higher depending on the plan. Call +1 (800) 888-8888 to confirm your exact ETF before initiating cancellation.

Q: Does Greenix treat fire ants in Texas?
